

# Get Help Paying for Child Care



The Child Care Facilitated Enrollment Project helps working families in New York City's five boroughs qualify for subsidized child care for children up to age 13.

Both parents in the household must live in New York City and work at least 20 hours per week.

This subsidy can be used for any type of child care provider that's willing to accept the voucher - licensed, unlicensed, summer camps, etc.

Use the link below to be pre-screened for eligibility. If you are determined eligible for subsidy, you will be sent an application and will need to provide the following documentation:

- 1. Proof of Income:** Copies of their most recent pay-stubs (1 month's worth if their gross remains the same/3 months worth if it varies) or submit the "Employee Income Information" form, which may be obtained only from the project office.
- 2. Verification of Birth:** Copies of either Birth certificate(s), passport(s) or baptismal certificate(s) for each child under 18 years.
- 3. Proof of Address:** A copy of a utility bill, lease agreement, etc.
